Italy's Political System

- Parliament is divided into two bodies
 - Chamber of Deputies
 - Senate of the Republic
- There are currently two coalitions
 - The Union
 - House of Freedoms
- The population votes on the party they want to represent them, not the candidates.

Data Description

■ 12 Parties and 7 Bills were used.

■ Values represent the percent of votes in each party that were in favor of each bill.

■ Abstains were counted as absent votes.

All values are between zero and one, inclusive.

The Union

Self-Organizing Map (SOM)

- A means of graphically displaying a set of data.
- Each square in the graph represents a series of seven percents, one for each bill.
- Training occurs by finding the most similar square, then making it and its neighbors more like the training values.
- A distance formula determines how similar each square is to the values entered.

SOM, cont' d

■ The closer each square is to another, the more the data the two squares represent are similar.

Once the training is done, the distance formula is used one last time to place labels on appropriate squares.

$$\sqrt{(p_1 - q_1)^2 + (p_2 - q_2)^2 + \dots + (p_n - q_n)^2} = \sqrt{\sum_{i=1}^n (p_i - q_i)^2}$$

Results, cont' d

■ The graph shows that the coalitions are well formed.

The boundary between the two coalitions seems smaller on the graph than what the numbers portray.

■ From the actual numbers, The Union seemed to show a lack of diversity.
