

Registering for Microsoft ELMS for DreamSpark Software (2016-2017)

Math & Computer Science Department – Webster University

Students currently enrolled in one of the Math & Computer Science department’s computing courses in St. Louis may download a variety of free Microsoft software via the department’s ELMS for DreamSpark web store.

Students must be registered and validated in order to download software. Your instructor will request an account for each student.

Examples include:

Windows 7 / 8 / 10 Visual Studio Project Access Visio Streets & Trips etc.


- 1) Visit the department’s ELMS for DreamSpark web store:



- 2) Click on “Register” in the upper right hand corner of the screen:



- 3) You will then receive an email in your official Webster email account with further instructions. (Check your junk folder)

- 4) Open the email and click on the link to complete your registration.



- 5) Enter your first and last name, choose and confirm a password (eg your connections password).
Type the requested text, and select "register"

- 6) After you see the message that registration has been successfully completed, choose the "Home" link in the upper right hand corner.




- 7) Proceed to the Download Procedures on the next page.


- 1) Make sure that you have completed the registration procedures (pages 1 - 2)
- 2) If you signed out after completing registration, follow the procedures on page 4 to sign back in.

- 3) Select "All" to view all available products.



- 4) Then scroll down to select the software that you want to download.

- 5) Add your selected software to the cart.
(As an example, Visual Studio was the selected software.)



- 6) Click on the "Express Checkout" button.



- 7) Read and "accept" the agreement by clicking on the next "Express Checkout" button.
